- II. To renew the existing position, the interested party should submit a new application five (5) working days before the end of the concession.
- III. For changes or cancellations of berths, you must inform our Service in writing, to avoid unnecessary inconvenience.
- IV. The M.P.F.S. reserves the right to change your position when the needs of the orderly operation and safety of the docked vessels require it.
- V. The owners/captains of vessels docked in the ports of Salamina are governed by the General regulations of the Port of Piraeus as well as by all applicable provisions on docking.
- VI. The compensation for the stay in the ports of Salamina is calculated according to the J.M.D. 8122.1/29/2014 (Official Gazette 2032/B/25.07.2014).
